

AUSTRALIA - THE NEED

WE LIVE IN A RAPIDLY GROWING COUNTRY WITH A DECLINING FAITH.

Australia is a growing, urbanised country. With the population growing by a million people every 2-3 years and 85% of the population living in cities. New churches are needed because while growing in number of people Australian cities are declining in number of Christians. In 2016, the National Church Life Survey calculated 16% of Australians go to church once a month compared to 44% in 1950. The most generous estimates suggest 8% of Australians attend church weekly (McCrindle Research 2013).

WE NOW LIVE IN A POST-CHRISTIAN COUNTRY, WHERE THE MAJORITY OF AUSTRALIANS ARE NOT FOLLOWERS OF JESUS OR KNOW SOMEONE WHO IS.

We live in a time where people have negative perceptions about the church, due to church abuse, corruption and judgmentalism. And yet according to research by Tim Sims, Australians are not as hostile to Christianity or churchgoing as people think, with 43% of Australians still believing Jesus rose from the dead, 45% believe in life after death and a staggering 74% still believe God exists.

WE LIVE IN A NEW AGE WHERE YOUNGER GENERATIONS ARE THE KEY INFLUENCES OF CULTURE, ECONOMY AND EDUCATION.

According to McCrindle's top 6 trends for 2019, from 2019, "there will be more Australians born since 1980 than before 1980". Meaning Generation Y (1980-1994) and Generation Z (1995-2009) will make up most of the workforce, outnumbering Generation X and Baby Boomers for the first time, becoming the key demographic for churches to engage with.

OUR COUNTRY NEEDS GOSPEL MEN AND WOMEN WHO HAVE A HOLY DISCONTENT FOR THE LOW IMPACT OF THE GOSPEL IN OUR COUNTRY.

As Jesus promised, the harvest is plentiful, and a great opportunity lies before us. But labourers are needed. Servants are needed. Disciple makers are needed. Our generation needs men and women who will believe in Jesus' promise to build his church. To reach more people, existing churches need to multiply, and new churches need to be planted.

WHY PLANT CHURCHES?

CHURCH PLANTING IS BIBLICAL

In the New Testament, church planting was the primary strategy for fulfilling Jesus' Great Commission. A new church is born when new disciples are made, new believers are baptised, and Jesus' words are studied in community (Acts 2:41–47). The book of Acts is a historical record of the church-planting movement; a movement that continues today.

CHURCH PLANTING RENEWS EXISTING CHURCHES

Church plants are the innovation department of the church. Older churches can be reluctant to try new ideas but will be encouraged to, once they see other churches try new ideas. In addition, new churches attract new people and produce new leaders, of which many eventually find their way into other churches within the city.

CHURCH PLANTING IS EFFECTIVE

As Peter Wagner says, "Planting churches is the most effective evangelistic methodology known under heaven." And as Tim Keller has argued based on research - new churches are 3-6 times more effective than established churches at reaching people with the gospel. This is most likely because new churches best reach new generations, new residents and new people by being new themselves and contextualising the gospel in a new way.

CHURCH PLANTING GENERATES NEW LEADERS

Church plants create energy, momentum, urgency and high ownership, challenging Christians to not just go to church but be the church, on mission for Jesus with the gifts, resources and influence they have.



A GROWING CITY

About 300,000 people call Wollongong home, making it the tenth-largest city in Australia. In the next 20 years, Wollongong is anticipated to grow between 15 to 20%, seeing growth through an influx of students wanting to study at the world-class University of Wollongong and influx of families escaping the soaring house prices of Sydney.

A TRANSFORMED CITY

It is an affordable city that people want to live in, with an average age of 34. In the last 5 years, the city has been transformed after \$1.3 billion dollars was invested into the city. The region is diverse, with many immigrants, lower socioeconomic areas that are being gentrified and the largest Buddhist temple in the Southern Hemisphere. Wollongong is a tourist destination that people are flocking to see, with the Pacific Ocean to the east and the stunning Illawarra Escarpment to the west.

A CITY THAT NEEDS JESUS

It has a growing irreligious population (~30%), numerous lower socioeconomic suburbs, an ongoing crystal meth problem, and a large immigrant community.

A CITY THAT NEEDS NEW CHURCHES

The city has good churches but needs more. New churches are needed throughout the region, and the vision for City on a Hill Wollongong would be to plant churches throughout the region of Wollongong.

City on a Hill began in Melbourne in October 2007, with a small team and a big vision to make a difference for the glory of God.


Meeting initially as a small group bible study in a city apartment, throughout our journey, God has done incredibly more than we could ever think or imagine. We have seen hundreds of men and women find new life in Christ and enter the waters of baptism. We have celebrated with those who have reconnected back to following Jesus. We've seen God inspire leaders and volunteers to care for the poor and marginalised, pioneer new ministries, train leaders, equip and send out of missionaries near and far, and open many doors for the gospel.

Today, City on a Hill is a movement of 2,500 men and women who are gathered across seven local churches, in four cities, in two states, all united around one mission – "to know Jesus and make Jesus known".

OUR VISION

To reach 10 cities with the beauty, truth and relevance of Jesus by planting 50 churches.

City on a Hill Wollongong will become the 8th City on a Hill church in the 5th city. The prayer is that it would be the first of many churches in the region of Wollongong. A vision we hope would awaken sleepy Christians, save souls, change the city and raise humble, courageous, sacrificial leaders to reach Wollongong and beyond.



OUR CULTURAL DISTINCTIVES

GOSPEL CONFIDENCE

Gospel confidence means that we will be by nature courageous and expectant. We will pursue big vision. We will engage in a movement of God's Spirit that is bigger than us. We will step up and out in dependence on God and his power, his redemptive plan, and his love for all would believe.

UNITY AND TRUST

Beginning with our leaders, we prioritise trust and unity, serving each other as we are called to do. From our members to our leadership alike, we will pursue a 'we'/'together' mindset – a unity which begins in our church locations and extends to our broader movement of churches.

CULTURAL ENGAGEMENT

Our posture is to hold fast to the timeless message of Jesus while making the most of timely methods. OUR VISION FOR CITY ON A HILL WOLLONGONG

① MISSION - A CITY ON A HILL THAT ILLUMINATES THE BEAUTY OF JESUS

Our heart desires to see more people in the beautiful city of Wollongong come to know the beauty of Jesus. Our prayer is that the church will be a sanctuary where sin is exposed, the grace of Jesus is proclaimed, and people respond with continual repentance and faith.

We will show radical hospitality and throw gospel parties.

We will equip evangelists, befriend sinners and engage culture.

② MERCY: A BODY THAT SACRIFICIALLY SERVES OTHERS

The church will be a diverse place where servants use their gifts for the good of the church and the city.

We will love the marginalised and the poor of Wollongong and have a heart to shine the light of love, justice, and hope to the needy in our world.

3 GOSPEL COMMUNITIES: A FAMILY BOUND BY THE BLOOD OF JESUS

In the context of a lonely world, we will gather in community knowing we were designed to flourish in community.

We will gather in rows on Sundays and in circles throughout the week to encourage one another in the gospel and warn one another about the isolating dangers of sin.

④ KIDS AND YOUTH: A HOME TO ENJOY AND LEARN ABOUT GOD

The church will be a place where kids, and adults enjoy God and one another. Jesus loves kids and so do we.

Our plan is that our first appointment will be a City Kids Coordinator.

A SANCTUARY

By the word of God and encouragement of the saints, the church will be a place where hearts are shocked into repentance and souls are stirred to worship.

We will be a place where seekers and sceptics are welcomed to experience God (1 Corinthians 14:24–25).

⑥ MULTIPLICATION: A CHURCH-PLANTING CHURCH

City on a Hill's vision is to plant 50 churches in 10 cities, which means City on a Hill Wollongong will be praying and planning towards being a healthy church that plants more healthy churches throughout Wollongong and beyond.

OUR PRAYER

Our prayer is that the Holy Spirit would be poured out on the Illawarra, so that we would see a movement of renewed affections, reformed minds, and revived souls.

Our prayer is that the beautiful gospel of Jesus would be proclaimed and promoted so that we would see deep spiritual formation and the radical salvation of many.

To reach this vision, we need gospel hearted leaders and servants who are willing to take a big step of faith in joining the church plant. We need men and women who are willing to use their God-given gifts, talents, treasures, influence and wisdom for building Jesus' church.
